STUDY AT THE UNIVERSITY OF EXETER

Our International Summer School delivers the complete study abroad experience in just three weeks. It is an opportunity to explore the UK, visit London and study with students from around the world, as well as with some of Exeter's undergraduates. New to 2018, it is now possible to study in both sessions for six weeks and receive 15 ECTS credits.

Session 1 starts with a 4 day orientation in London, giving you time to get to know your fellow students and then travel to the university to begin your classes. Session 1 also provides the opportunity to study at our unique Penryn Campus in Cornwall, providing a specialised environment for the courses.

Session 2 gives you the opportunity to get to know your fellow students on campus and, after the classes have finished, enjoy a celebratory trip to London with your classmates.

Outside of class, you will be able to experience all aspects of British culture and visit some truly unique places.

Academic programme

Our academic programme will give you an invaluable experience of studying at a leading British university.

- Each course is accredited at 15 Exeter credits and 7.5 ECTS – equivalent to a semester module – and typically transfers as 3 credits in North America
- Teaching will be delivered by Exeter's faculty through a mix of lectures, seminars, labs, debates and IT sessions depending on your chosen subject
- Two taught sessions per day between 10am and 3pm, plus you should expect to undertake around 2 hours independent study per day
- You will have full access to the campus facilities including the library, IT network and course Moodle site
- Assessment is by presentation, exam or essay

Social programme

London Orientation and Farewell

Session 1 will commence with a 4 day orientation in London and Session 2 will end with a 4 day celebration in London.

Staff will be in London throughout your stay and will either meet you at the hotel or airport on arrival day or accompany you to the airport on departure day at the end of both session 1 and session 2. Bed and breakfast accommodation will be at the Travelodge Covent Garden, which is in the very centre of the city.

The programme includes:

- Watching a play at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre
- Visiting the British Museum or other famous museums such as the Natural History Museum
- A visit to the Tower of London or another of the Queen's Palaces in London
- Free time to explore

During the academic programme

Outside of classes there will be a number of social events on campus, daytrips to some of the UK's top destinations (such as Bath and St Ives) and a free weekend for independent travel.

Accommodation

Accommodation is provided in Exeter on campus at our St German's complex. We offer a bed and breakfast package and the accommodation includes a fully equipped kitchen for other meals.

Accommodation in Penryn is provided in Glasney Lodge – one of our on campus accommodations. We offer the same catering package as the accommodation in Exeter.


About Exeter

Entry requirements

Our minimum entry requirements are:

- A GPA of 3.0 or equivalent
- An IELTS score of 6.5 or equivalent, such as TOEFL or CET

The total fee per session of the programme is £2,350 and includes:

- All administration and registration to the University of Exeter

The total fee for both Session 1 and 2 is £4,200.
